FAQ

Q: How does the referral program work?

Cambridge Network is always looking for new international students to join the Cambridge Network community. If you refer a qualified international student, we'll pay you a referral bonus.

Q: Who is considered a qualified international student?

A qualified international student is someone who meets the following criteria:

- Has never previously applied for any service(s) with Cambridge Network;
- Enrolls in a Fall or Spring semester at one of our partner schools in the U.S.; and/or
- Stays with one of our Cambridge Network host families for more than 30 days; and
- Pays for all services in full.

Q: How much is the referral bonus?

As a referrer, YOU are a(n)	Amount
Non-senior Cambridge student	\$2,000 USD in CAC-AS services or Apple product(s) up to \$1,000 USD
Senior Cambridge student	\$2,000 USD in scholarship with proof of enrollment to a U.S. university/college
Everyone else	\$2,000 USD

Cambridge Network reserves the right to change this amount at its discretion.

Q: Who is considered a referral?

Only friends and family. You may only send referral messages to close friends and non-immediate family members. For example, you can refer your brother's son who does not live with you, but you cannot refer your own children.

Q: Can I refer myself?

No. Our referral program is only for referring other people.



Q: Can I refer a Cambridge Network employee and their immediate family members?

No. Our referral program is only for referring people who are outside of the Cambridge Network, including employees and their immediate family members.

Q: What happens if two people refer the same student?

Only one person can receive a referral bonus per qualified student. Cambridge Network reserves the right to decide who is the rightful recipient of the referral bonus in the case that more than one person refers the same student.

Q: How do I make sure I will get paid for the referral?

A prospective student must put your name, email, and phone number on their inquiry form or application for you to receive payment for their referral.

Q: Can I refer the same student twice?

No, you can only refer a student once, regardless of whether they are deemed eligible or ineligible to be a Cambridge Network student at that time.

Q: How does Cambridge Network deliver the referral bonus?

If we notify you that you are eligible to receive a referral bonus AND you are not a Cambridge student, you must complete a W-9 and provide us with your direct deposit information to receive your bonus. You will be contacted up to a maximum of three times after you have earned the referral bonus. The referral bonus shall be deemed forfeited by you if you do not complete necessary documents within ten calendar days after Cambridge Network's third contact attempt. If you are a Cambridge student who referred another student, Cambridge will contact you to arrange the delivery of the bonus.

Q: How often is the referral bonus paid out?

Referral bonuses will be paid out four times per year. For students who become qualified referrals between September and November, the referral bonus will be paid out in January. For students who become qualified referrals between December and February, the referral bonus will be paid out in April. For students who become qualified referrals between March and May, the referral bonus will be paid out in July. For students who become qualified referrals between June and August, the referral bonus will be paid out in October.

Q: Are there any qualifications for me as the referrer?

Yes. You must be at least 18 years old and a legal resident of the United States or you are an existing Cambridge student.

Q: What are the age limits for the students I refer?

Students vary in age, but most potential Cambridge Network students are high school- or college-aged, generally between 15 and 22 years old.



Program Rules

Program Overview

The Cambridge Network International Student Referral Program rewards people who refer students to us. Please see the criteria below for referrers to receive compensation.

To be eligible to receive a referral bonus as a referrer, you must be both a legal resident of the United States and at least 18 years old.

The Referral Bonus

You can receive a referral bonus for each qualified international student you refer.

As a referrer, YOU are a(n)	Amount
Non-senior Cambridge student	\$2,000 USD in CAC-AS services or Apple product(s) up to \$1,000 USD
Senior Cambridge student	\$2,000 USD in scholarship with proof of enrollment to a U.S. university/college
Everyone else	\$2,000 USD

Only one person can receive a referral bonus for each student referred. In the event that multiple persons claim credit for a particular referral, Cambridge Network has full discretion to determine which person earned such referral according to Cambridge Network's systems.

A qualified international student is defined as someone who meets the following criteria:

- Has never previously applied for any service(s) with Cambridge Network;
- Enrolls in a Fall or Spring semester at one of our partner schools in the U.S.; and/or
- Stays with one of our Cambridge Network host families for more than 30 days; and
- Pays for all services in full.

Please note that the referral bonus and the reward criteria are set by Cambridge Network and are subject to change at any time. The Reward Criteria may vary by market or within a particular market. Cambridge Network, at its sole discretion, may make available certain promotions with different reward criteria or referral bonus to other users or prospective users.

Cambridge Network reserves the right to withhold or deduct referral bonuses obtained through the referral program in the event that Cambridge Network determines or believes that the receipt of the referral bonus was in error, fraudulent, illegal, or in violation of these referral program rules.



How to Refer Students

You can refer your friends, family or contacts to become Cambridge Network students via the Cambridge Network website.

The following criteria must ALL be met in order for you to be eligible to receive a referral bonus:

- The referred student must be qualified.
- The referred student cannot be an existing employee of Cambridge Network or an immediate family member of the employee of Cambridge Network.
- The referred student must have indicated the referrer's full name, email, and phone on their inquiry form or student application.

You, as the referrer, must provide a completed W-9 and direct deposit information to Cambridge Network when you are notified that you are entitled to receive a referral bonus. You will be contacted up to a maximum of three times after you have earned the referral bonus. The referral bonus shall be deemed forfeited by you if you do not complete necessary documents within ten calendar days after Cambridge Network's third contact attempt. If you are a Cambridge student who referred another student, Cambridge will contact you to arrange the delivery of the bonus.

Payout Period

Referral bonuses will be paid out four times per year. For students who become qualified referrals between September and November, the referral bonus will be paid out in January. For students who become qualified referrals between December and February, the referral bonus will be paid out in April. For students who become qualified referrals between March and May, the referral bonus will be paid out in July. For students who become qualified referrals between June and August, the referral bonus will be paid out in October.

Regulations

The following activities are not permitted in the referral program:

- **a. Spamming.** "Spamming" anyone with invitations to join the Cambridge Network community is not permitted and Cambridge Network will remain compliant with CAN-SPAM, the TCPA, and other applicable laws at all times.
- **b.** Use of scripts, programs, or automatic dialers. Creating or using any script, program, bots, predictive dialers, or other automated systems to facilitate the sending of invitations or communications to any person is not permitted.
- **c. Misrepresentations.** Making any misrepresentations concerning Cambridge Network or the characteristics or qualification requirements for any referral bonus is not permitted. As Cambridge Network may change the characteristics or qualification requirements for the referral



bonus at its discretion, representing any fixed characteristics (e.g., amount of credit, expiration date) is not permitted.

- **d. Advertising.** Paying to advertise the referral program, including but not limited to on Google, Facebook, Twitter, Bing and Craigslist, is not permitted for any persons not directly employed by Cambridge Network.
- e. Fraud or abuse. Defrauding or abusing (or attempting to defraud or abuse) Cambridge Network, the terms of the Cambridge Network student referral program, or any invited users is not permitted.

If any of these restrictions are violated, Cambridge Network may, at its discretion, remove your eligibility to participate in the referral program, and/or deny you any referral bonus earned in violation of, or suspected violation of, these restrictions.

Referrers cannot earn referral bonuses for referring immediate family members.

All Cambridge Network promotions run for a limited time only, and are subject to change at Cambridge Network's discretion.

Cambridge Network employees and their immediate family members are subject to the Cambridge Network International Student Referral Program Rules for Employees.
