



The class itself is reserved for critical discussions and one-on-one academic writing support. Seniors enrolled in our College Advance class truly have a leg-up on their fellow students. Our instructors have been helping students achieve their college entrance dreams for years and have helped student gain entrance to the most competitive universities in the United States.

CUSTOMIZED TUTORING HELPS STUDENT AT EVERY LEVEL AND IN ANY SUBJECT!

For the first time, Cambridge Network's Academic Services is extending our incredible **Tutoring Services** programs directly to the students enrolled in our Academic Services partner schools. If your school opens this option to you, you may choose to enroll in up to 35 hours of one-on-one online tutoring. (Number of hours is determined by tutoring subject and tutor availability.)

This tutoring can cover all academic subjects (science, math, social studies, etc.), all academic levels (CP, honors, or AP), intensive English as a second language skill building, or SAT/ACT/ TOEFL test prep. The tutoring is conducted online and according to the student's schedule.


